By Transfer of Letter If you are a member of another Baptist church, a letter of membership is simply transferred to our church. We take care of the process

By Watchcare If you are in town on a temporary basis (e.g. a college student) or if you were baptized in a manner other than by immersion, you may still unite in fellowship
