By Statement of Christian Experience If you are a member of another denomination or unaffiliated church and have been baptized by immersion, you may become a member by simple acknowledgement of such and of your desire to join. If you made a profession of your faith earlier in life but have not been baptized by immersion you are still welcome to membership by baptism.

By Transfer of Letter If you are a member of another Baptist church, a letter of membership is simply transferred to our church. We take care of the process

By Watchcare If you are in town on a temporary basis (e.g. a college student) or if you were baptized in a manner other than by immersion, you may still unite in fellowship
